

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 All exhibits for prizes must have been grown or produced by, or be entirely the work of the exhibitor, except where otherwise stated.
- 2 **All exhibits must be staged in the Hall between 8.00 and 9.45 am on Show Day, no unauthorised person may remain during the judging.**
- 3 Admission to the Show will be £1.00. Children under 16 are free.
- 4 **Entries must be made on the official entry forms and must be submitted by 8.00 p.m. on Thursday 28th March 2019.**
All Classes must be distinctly specified according to the schedule.
- 5 Vases supplied by the society must be used for all cut flowers and foliage entries. In the classes for effect, exhibitors must provide their own containers.
- 6 Flowers are to be shown with their own foliage only, except where specified. Competitors' exhibits must be strictly confined to the space allotted under penalty of disqualification.
- 7 No exhibit or card shall be removed before 4 pm. Prize money not collected by 4 pm will be considered a contribution to the funds of the society.
- 8 The committee cannot be responsible for any damage done to, or loss of, exhibits etc. during the show, but at the same time they will see that every possible care is taken of them.
- 9 No exhibitor may enter more than **2 exhibits** in each class.
- 10 The judges have the power to withhold any prize through lack of competition, merit or infringement. The decision of the judges shall be final.
- 11 Any objection to an exhibit must be lodged with the secretary in writing before 3 pm with a deposit of £5, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- 12 The committee reserve the right to move any exhibit, and have the power to refuse any exhibit whatsoever.
- 13 Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-4 points; 2nd- 2 points; 3rd- 1 point.

SECTION A --BULBS, CORMS, RHIZOMES IN A POT, PAN or BOWL

Note: Daffodil is the popular name of the group of plants botanically known as Narcissus. The terms are interchangeable. If you are in any doubt, please bring all your blooms and we will endeavour to advise you as to the correct class. Guidance is also available on our website.

- 1 Hyacinth - any colour, 1 bulb.
- 2 Hyacinth - any colour, 3 bulbs or more.
- 3 Narcissi - trumpet type, any number.
- 4 Narcissi - double, any number.
- 5 Narcissi - dwarf, any number.
- 6 Narcissi Cyclameneus (i.e .reflex petals such as Jetfire), any number.
- 7 Narcissi any other not mentioned in classes 3-6, any number.
- 8 Tulips, any variety, any number.

SECTION B -----CUT FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE

- 9 Corms, rhizome or any other bulb.

- 10 Hellebore Heads-single flowers, 3 heads, same variety.
- 11 Hellebore Heads-double flowers, 3 heads, same variety.
- 12 Narcissi - Trumpet type, 3 stems same variety.
- 13 Narcissi - any other, any number same variety.
- 14 Narcissi - Mixed varieties, 10 stems.
- 15 An arrangement of Spring flowers.
- 16 Flowering shrub - one variety.

RECIPE

Lemon Drizzle Loaf

Ingredients:

2 Lemons
2 Eggs—beaten together
6oz Caster Sugar
4oz Margarine
6oz Self Raising Flour
3 tspn Icing Sugar

2lb Lined Loaf Tin, approx. 23cm x 11cm.

Cream together sugar and margarine.

Beat in eggs a little at a time.

Fold in flour, grated rind of both lemons, 1 tspn lemon juice and a little milk to make a soft consistency.

Bake at 150°C/Gas Mark 2 for approx. 30-40 minutes till firm to the touch.

While hot and still in the tin, stab the cake all over with a fine skewer.

Mix remaining juice with the icing sugar and pour over cake. Dust with caster sugar when cold.

Note: Plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for at least 3 months.

- 18 One fern— any size.
- 19 Alpine(s), pot or pan.
- 20 One flowering pot plant—pot size up to 5" (125 cm).
- 21 One flowering plant—pot size above 5".
- 22 One foliage plant—pot size up to 5".
- 23 One foliage plant—pot size above 5".
- 24 Outdoor container—planted trough, pot, box—must be grown outside.

SECTION D ----- FLORAL ART

*(Flowers may have been purchased. Accessories allowed.)
(Prizes for Floral Art Classes £5, £3, £2.)*

- 25 A Spring Surprise—not to exceed 24" width/depth/height.
